



Fenway Foundation/FHANA Charitable Award Form

Background

The *FHANA Charitable Award* was established in 2018 to recognize the contributions of FHANA members who are actively engaged in community service or charitable efforts. This annual award acknowledges and honors FHANA members who strive to improve their community's social welfare and/or the quality of life of its citizens. In the spirit of FHANA's mission to preserve, protect, and promote the Friesian horse, this special recognition award is given to a FHANA member or Chapter in good standing for their contributions to preserve, support or protect their communities and/or the welfare of animals.

Award Criteria

When judging the winners, FHANA will be using the following criteria:

- The objectives and nature of the charitable work;
- Example(s) that demonstrates the charity had a positive impact;
- That the charitable work that can be replicated and/or sustained if applicable;
- Nominations for this award can be made by one of two ways:
 - A FHANA member who is in good standing can self-submit their own award nomination.
 - A FHANA member who is in good standing can nominate another FHANA member in good standing or a FHANA recognized Chapter.

Selection Process

- The award application covers the time frame from 1 December to 30 November of the preceding calendar year.
- The FMC will select three FMC members to review the application(s). These individuals will make an award recommendation to the FMC who in turn will forward the nomination(s) to FHANA.
- The attached form will be utilized to submit an award nomination. Nominees will be evaluated using the above criteria.
