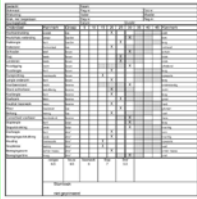



THE 2016 FHANA CENTRAL MARE SHOW

This exciting inaugural event will be held in conjunction with the IFSHA World Show, October 5-9, 2016 at the Champions Center Expo in Springfield, Ohio.

All classes in the Mare Show will be judged by KFPS Judges. Mares entered in this special competition may enter other events at the IFSHA show, but must be shod in accordance with KFPS leuring guidelines.

Four preliminary classes will be offered by age group (3 year olds; 4 & 5 year olds; 6 & 7 year olds; 8 and over) in which ribbons to 6th place will be awarded. The top two mares from each class will show back for the Championship on Saturday night. The Champion will receive \$1500.00 and other prizes. Reserve Champion will receive \$1000.00.

Registering a Foal

FHANA will no longer be sending out Breeding certificates for your mares that were bred in 2015.

To register your foal, follow the following steps

1. Log into website using your **KFPS R# and passcode**. If you don't know this number, please contact the office and we can send it to you.
2. If you aren't already redirected to the portal. Click on Breeding at the top of the page. Once there, click on Link to "**MYKFPS**".
3. This will redirect you to the KFPS portal.
4. Click on **Foal Registration**
5. Select the mare that was bred
6. This will direct you to a new screen where you will enter the foal information. Name, Date of Birth, Sex, New owner if one is applicable.
7. Enter your credit card information.
8. Click the "**Save**" at the bottom.
9. You will receive a notification that says "Your horse is now registered followed by the respective registration number"

This does not complete the process.

You will receive a notification email that is in Dutch. We are working on this to get this translated and sent to you in English.

Once you have registered the foal, FHANA receives a notification and we will process the registration. From this notification FHANA will then send you your Micro Chip and DNA kit which needs to be completed prior to attending an inspection.

This process is new to everyone including the office. We appreciate your patience as we work through any bugs that may come up during the process.

If you are experiencing issues, please contact the office and we will walk you through the process.

ABFP Fees...Explained

ABFP Testing: As most of you are aware, young stallions cannot obtain their full permanent breeding license until they have had 20 adult offspring complete this testing. The KFPS expects this to be accomplished following the stallion's 6th breeding season by testing 3

and 4 year olds from his first two years at stud. If this is not completed in a timely manner, the KFPS can and will suspend a stallion's breeding license. Stallions approved here in North America are required to stand at stud here for at least those first two years, and we, of course, wish to keep them here long after that. There is no way to accomplish this offspring testing in a timely manner for these stallions unless we can do it here in North America.
