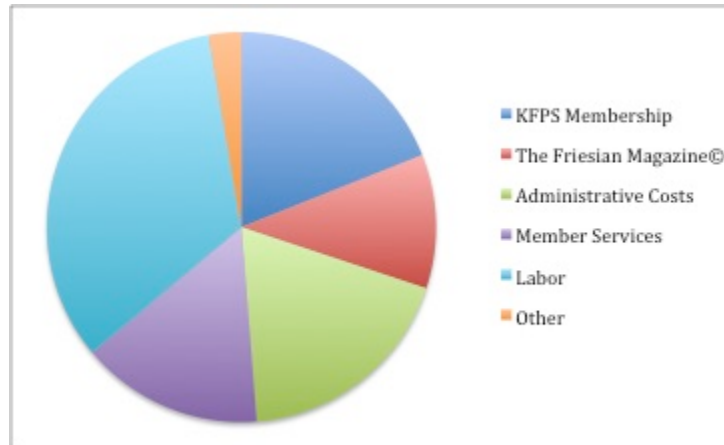

Information from the Office:

Effective starting 2018: Starting in 2018, FHANA will follow the policy currently in place regarding the testing for Hydrocephalus and Dwarfism. That policy is as follows-All new ster mares will be tested at the completion of the 2018 inspections. The fee for the testing is \$50 and will be billed to each member and must be paid before your papers are returned.

Starting in 2019-All breeding stock will be tested if it hasn't been tested already. You will receive an invoice from FHANA for the fee when you register your foal.

If both sire and dam are negative, then testing of the offspring is not required.

FHANA would still encourage members to have their mares voluntarily tested.
